Summary

The Pagham to West Bognor Regis frontage is a relatively sheltered southeast facing stretch, backed by residential properties. Although no retaining structures are in place in this Unit, the shingle berm maintains a width of up to 40m along the eastern two-thirds of the Unit, its stability reflected by the presence of relatively dense undisturbed shingle vegetation.
